Known Issues

The wording of

OSR 3.14.1 e) regarding the placement of stanchion bases, and

OSR 3.17.1 regarding the placement of toe rails or foot-stops are causing some confusion. This urgent issue is being addressed by World Sailing.

	3.04	Stability – Monohulls
**	3.14.1	e) <u>if a boat's first launch date is after 2024,</u> the outside of pulpit and stanchion base tubes no further inboard from the <u>perimeter of the</u> deck than 5% of boat beam or 150 mm (6"), whichever is greater, nor further outboard than the <u>perimeter of the deck, where the perimeter of the deck is defined as the hull and deck intersection at an angle of not more than 15 degrees to the horizontal in a transverse plane when the yacht is upright,</u>
